Admission Requirements

1. During the family interview at least one parent must be able and willing to clearly articulate a saving relationship with Jesus Christ. Both parents should have a clear understanding of the biblical philosophy and functioning of Dominion Classical Christian Academy. Both parents must read the Statement of Faith and accept that it constitutes the doctrinal beliefs of the school and agree to have their children taught in accordance with the Statement of Faith.
2. The parents must be committed to cooperating with the policies of the school board. This is most important in the areas of discipline and schoolwork.
3. Parents must understand the school’s commitment to parental responsibility for their child’s education. Dominion Classical Christian Academy exists to assist parents in the task of educating their children, not to take over responsibility for the education of their children. Dominion Classical Christian Academy requires parents to be very actively engaged and involved in the education of their children.
4. A child must reach the age of five (5) years by September 1st of the year in which he enters Kindergarten at Dominion Classical Christian Academy. All children applying for admission to Kindergarten must perform satisfactorily on the Kindergarten Entrance Assessment.
5. Generally, a child who has not completed Kindergarten at Dominion Classical Christian Academy must reach the age of six (6) years by September 1st of the year in which he enters first grade at Dominion Classical Christian Academy.
6. Children entering subsequent grades will be admitted to a grade based on having successfully completed the previous grade at home or at another school and having performed satisfactorily on an Admissions Assessment Tests for the grade to which they are applying.
7. Academic portfolios and/or copies of standardized achievement test scores and recent report cards for each student that is applying must be submitted with the Application for Admission. As part of the application process and evaluation, Dominion Classical Christian Academy will also examine the student’s records and transcripts from previous schools attended.
8. New students will be assessed in Reading, Writing, Math, and Grammar to determine their academic readiness for the program at Dominion Classical Christian Academy. Assessment results and prior records will be used to determine the suitability of the Dominion program for the student’s needs. Students who perform below the standards for entrance into a particular grade level may be recommended for placement in a lower grade.
9. The child should understand that his parents have delegated their authority to Dominion Classical Christian Academy while the child is in school. He is therefore subject to the instruction and discipline of the teachers and staff while in school.

Dominion Classical Christian Academy Statement of Faith

Dominion Classical Christian Academy, its staff, and its board members embrace the historic tenets of Christianity as presented in this Statement of Faith. We believe that the creeds of the early church and the major confessions of the Protestant Reformation are credible summations of biblical orthodoxy. We are in essential agreement with these creeds and confessions when they speak to the doctrinal issues addressed in this Statement of Faith. Beyond the primary doctrines articulated in the Statement of Faith below, we respect and acknowledge the primacy of the family and local churches and refer any secondary doctrinal questions to parents and local churches for clarification.

- A. We believe that the 66 books of the Old and New Testaments are alone the perfect, inspired, infallible, and authoritative Word of God, and as such, rightly interpreted, they are the final authority in faith and practice.
- B. We believe that there is only one God, eternally existent in three Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, who is infinite, eternal, and unchangeable in His being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness, and truth; He alone is sovereign over all things, ordaining whatsoever comes to pass.
- C. We believe that God created all things out of nothing, for His own glory and good pleasure, and for the display of His eternal power, wisdom, and goodness; having created all things, God created man in His image, male and female, perfect, sinless, and immortal, and He charged mankind with the governance of the created world, to cultivate it for His glory.
- D. We believe in the historicity of Adam and Eve, our first parents; we believe that though they were created sinless, they did not remain in that perfect state, but willfully and consciously disobeyed their Creator's command. Consequently, the guilt of Adam's sin and his fallen nature are covenantally transferred to all mankind.
- E. We believe that God created and gifted men and women differently for different roles, and that such differences should not be minimized, but recognized, encouraged, and enjoyed.
- F. We believe in the deity and humanity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth during the reign of Caesar Augustus, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and sin-atonement death on a cross by the shedding of His blood, in His bodily resurrection from the dead, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.
- G. We believe that, for the salvation of lost and sinful men, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely necessary; salvation is a gift of God, received by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone, for the glory of God alone.
- H. We believe that faith without works is dead.
- I. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling Christians are enabled to live godly lives.
- J. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost – the saved to the resurrection of life, and the lost to the resurrection of damnation.
- K. We believe in the spiritual unity of all believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.
- L. We believe that the chief end of man is to glorify God and enjoy Him forever.
- M. We believe that parents are responsible for educating their children and for bringing them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
